2. Complete application **in full and in typed format**. *NB:* incomplete/handwritten applications will not be processed.
3. Ensure that you have **signed** the completed application

5. You may also post your typed application form if you prefer, attaching a passport size photo to **Admissions Office, Registry, Dublin City University, Collins Avenue, Dublin 9**. Your posted application must arrive by the closing date of 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
