## The Dublin Region Homeless Executive's Family Support Team

The DRHE however recognises that for families who are not eligible for housing support, a temporary arrangement may need to be put in place on a given day to avoid rough-sleeping.

On behalf of the Dublin Region Homeless Executive (DRHE), Focus Ireland has provided a service facilitating access to one night only accommodation, support and advice, to families who do not have entitlement to Social Housing Support and / or who may have a crisis need for accommodation.

From Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018 this service will transfer to the Central Placement Service, DRHE. Each individual local authority will continue as normal to assess applications for social housing support based on homelessness and make arrangements for temporary or long-term accommodation as appropriate.

On behalf of the four Dublin Authorities, the Family Support Team (within CPS) will provide emergency accommodation on an exceptional needs basis to families. As this is a crisis placement, the service will be on a one night only basis, as is normal in these circumstances and only one offer of accommodation will be made. The booking is to facilitate arrangements to be made with relevant services, as appropriate e.g. Department of Social Protection, Department of Justice, TUSLA, NGOs and regional local authorities.

Focus Ireland, funded by TUSLA, will continue to provide an evening support service which will offer advice, information, advocacy and practical support e.g. food and homework clubs to families in one night only accommodation or who are having difficulty sourcing self-accommodation.
